The Giving Tree will put clothing and gifts in the hands of children in need across Northern Orange & Sullivan Counties. Giving Tree host sites will display a non-denominational holiday tree, drawn by our Club kids, with ornaments that list a child's first name, age, and size/hobby information.

From November 8 through December 3, donors can sign up, take an ornament and return a gift for the child listed on their ornament.

From December 3 through December 23, the Club staff and volunteers will collect and distribute the gifts to Club kids and other children in need in our area. We help our Club kids and our campers, and then we also open the drive up to as many children as we can serve from communities outside our service area too!
