Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much does camp cost?

**For Town of Fallsburg Campers:
\$275 for the first child
\$225 for each additional child**

**For Non-Resident Campers:
\$500 for the first child
\$450 for each additional child**

2. If I only use one week of camp do I get a reduced rate/refunded?

NO, we do not offer any pro-rating. Any camper who is signed up, paid, and completes all paperwork has their spot guaranteed in our camp.

3. How old do you have to be to attend camp?

We begin taking campers who are entering kindergarten up to age 14.

4. Is lunch provided?

We will be providing FREE breakfast and lunch through the Fallsburg School District this year. Breakfast and lunch will be delivered to the site daily and distributed to campers who want it. A breakfast and lunch menu will be sent out ahead of time so families know what options their children have.

5. How does the camp day run?

For the campers in kindergarten through second grade a variety of activities are provided. These children will travel with the same group throughout the day.

For campers entering 3rd grade and up, a schedule will be created daily by our Camp Directors, and campers are given the opportunity to select the activity they prefer. Attendance is taken at each activity to account for every camper.

6. What should my child bring every day?

Children should bring a bathing suit and towel if they plan on going swimming. Lunch or money for concession, sneakers and any snacks or drinks they would like



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throughout the day. Water is available throughout the park for campers.

7. What activities can the children choose from?

Activities available at the summer camp include;

Soccer, Basketball, Swimming, Gamezone, Kickball, New Games, Softball, Arts & Crafts, Playground and many more.

8. What are the trips and how much do they cost?

There is one trip available each session. The trips are as follows:

Grades K-2 Camp

Forestburgh Playhouse-\$25- July 19

Holiday Mountain- \$35- August 1

Grades 3-9 Camp

Splash Down Beach- \$40- July 11

Rockland Boulders- \$40- July 25

9. What time does camp open?

Camp begins 9am and ends at 3pm.

10. How can I register for before/after camp?

During the online application process, you will be given the opportunity to register for before/after camp. Before camp begins at 6am and goes until camp starts. After camp starts at the conclusion of camp and all campers must be picked up by 6pm. The price break down is as follows:

Before Camp: \$150.00 per child

After Camp: \$150.00 per child

Campers can sign up for any combination of before/after camp. No pro-rating is available. Any late pick-ups (after 6PM) could be subject to additional fees.

11. When is the registration deadline?

The registration is a rolling process there is no set day to register. However, our Camps max capacity is 225 campers. It does fill up, so we recommend registering as soon as possible. Your child does not have a guaranteed spot until all paperwork, payment, and immunizations are submitted.



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12. How does swimming work?

Swimming is one of our most popular activities. The Morningside Park pool provides a great environment for water activities. All children are swim tested based on their abilities. The results of this test determine what area of depth the children are allowed to enter in the water. Upon entering the pool area the children are supervised by both camp staff and a team of certified lifeguards.

13. Can my child bring toys/electronics?

Yes, Camp is about having fun. We make sure to supply anything needed for our activities. We have found that many kids also like to bring items from home for use throughout the day. However, we are not responsible for any items lost/stolen during the camp day. When in doubt, leave it home.



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
